

## Advanced Course on Investigation & Detection of Crime

i) The CDTS, Kolkata conducts a 13-weeks Advanced Course on Investigation & Detection of Crime for police officers of the rank of ASI/SI/Insp. coming from different States of the country and also from abroad. It is the Flagship Course of CDTS, Kolkata and the syllabus of the Course has been recently revised this year, making it more field-oriented and emphasizing on out-of-classroom training and some new Modules have been incorporated. The revised syllabus includes the following 16 Modules:

ii) For the newly introduced Module No. XIV the trainees are sent in batches to nearby Police Stations for solving undetected but disposed off cases related to Offences against the body and Offences against the property, so that they can contribute their bit which may help in the process of detection of such cases.

iii) Evaluation Tests are conducted at the end of each Module. A session on case studies/experience sharing is held everyday.

iv) The amended syllabus includes a one-week Foreign Visit program, which will be implemented soon after getting approval from the competent authority.

v) An essay competition is organized for the participants of the Course and prizes are awarded to the winners.
