The training is imparted on the topics covering Status of women, social, psychological & economic status of women in India, gender equality & Constitutional/legal provisions/UN Conventions, Need for gender sensitization in police; Overview of different laws; Bias/Discrimination faced by women at work place, Judgment of Supreme Court in special cases; Trafficking of women- National/International case study, Role of NGO; SOP for dealing with missing women & children; Investigation of cases; Cyber crimes against women & Minor Acts. Investigation of cases of crime against women, Role of police in preventing crime; Registration of FIR; Role of Forensic Science; Problems faced by police in investigating cases; Role of various NGOs. The trainees are taken for a visit to the Rehabilitation Centre.
